Payment Information for Activities

Below is a step by step breakdown of the new payment procedure that should be followed:

STEP ONE

Book your activity by contacting Customer Service on 9490 4222.

STEP TWO

Payments must be made by the due date. (Please see each activity for due date).

STEP THREE

Council's Customer Service Officer will issue a receipt for any monies taken.

STEP FOUR

Please then show the receipt to the program organiser as proof of payment before the start of the program/activity. Bring this receipt, as proof of payment to each activity.

Participant's Information Form

On the last page of this newsletter, you will find a "Participant's Information Form". It is very important that this form is filled out and returned to Mel Ramsay on the next activity that you attend.

It is important that Council maintain accurate and current records of participants attending our program for safety reasons.

You will notice that there is a Privacy Statement at the end of the form that needs to be read, signed and dated. This is for you to acknowledge that Banyule City Council is keeping your personal details on file.

No refunds will be given for the Balwyn Cinema's or half day trips. This is due to Council being required to pre-pay for these activities. However, a full day trip refund is available if a Doctors certificate is submitted, so please make sure that you are able to attend the activity when booking and paying

PLEASE NOTE: In the event that an activity has been planned and the temperature reaches 35 degrees a decision to postpone the activity will be considered. You will be notified by phone on the day.

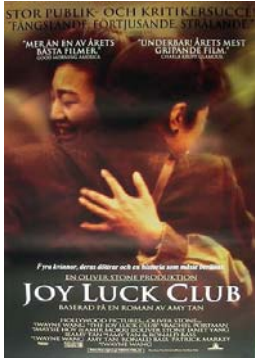

Car parking

The introduction of new parking rules has come into force at Council's car park at Ivanhoe. There is now only 3 hour parking. So if you need to park at Ivanhoe during an activity you will need to:

1. Ask for a parking permit from Customer Service when you pay for your outings. Leave this on the dashboard of your car on the day of outing.
2. When you arrive on the day of the outing present your receipt to Customer Service and receive your parking permit to put in your car.

Permits will only be issued when paying for an outing or on presentation of receipt.
