

Banyule is located northeast of the Melbourne CBD and is surrounded by five other Local Government Areas (LGAs) - Darebin, Whittlesea, Nillumbik, Manningham and Boroondara.

The demographic profile of Banyule compared to its neighbouring LGAs generally represents an average. That is, for each of the demographics presented below, Banyule has neither the highest nor the lowest value, but tends to sit around the middle. There are some notable exceptions.

Banyule has:

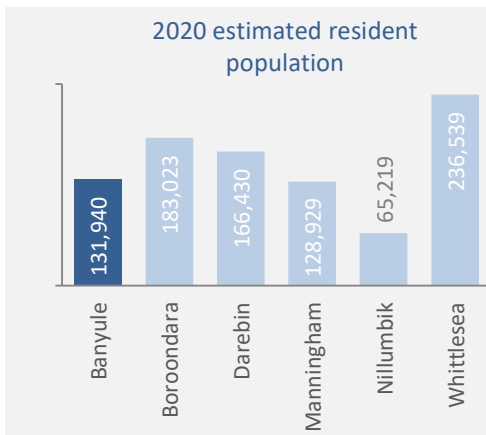
- the second lowest unemployment rate;
- the second lowest cultural diversity;
- the second highest social housing.

Of Banyule's neighbouring LGAs:

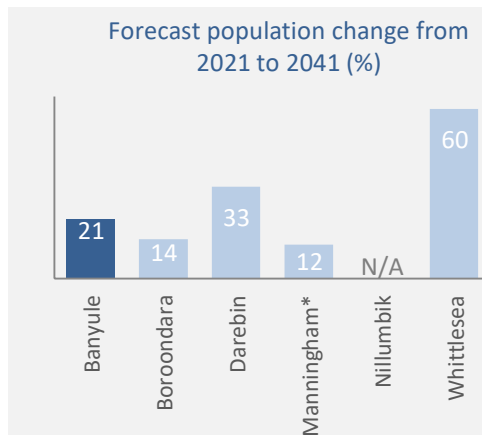
- Whittlesea has the highest population growth and the youngest age profile.
- Manningham has the oldest age profile and the highest proportion of residents born overseas.
- Boroondara and Nillumbik have the highest socio-economic profile.
- Nillumbik has the lowest cultural diversity.
- Darebin has the highest proportion of; people in the working age group of 25-64 years, lone person households, people in need of assistance and social housing.
