Guidance on BAC levels for Roles Activities and Sites

Employees will need to comply with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of zero where it;

arises from your duties, or

if deemed as "high-risk" by Council, or

in compliance with the Victorian Road Rules, or

in compliance with other legislation or regulations or

arising from Council or local policy/procedures.

For example;

A BAC of zero is required for (but is <u>not</u> limited to):

- Drivers of large (non-passenger) vehicles (including road-going plant);
- Learner and probationary drivers;
- Operators of plant, machinery and other equipment;
- Drivers with specific licence conditions imposed by relevant authorities;
- Where a work area determines that this is required for staff undertaking specified duties, including Duty Officers and after-hours on-call staff.
