Temporary Advertising Sign General Local Law (No 1)

Guide and Application



Purpose

These guidelines are to encourage participation within the community and to support community groups in their activities as well as also protecting the amenity of the municipality.

For Council to regulate and control signage on council land and to reduce the impact to the amenity of public spaces.

These guidelines do not apply to signage at sporting reserves or at event location sites.

Definition of Community group

A local community group is one that can demonstrate to the satisfaction of Council it is a non-profit group which provides a service to the community in general, or to a particular section of it and which has as a principle objective to the enhancement of the wellbeing of Banyule City Council residents.

Local Community groups from Banyule's Municipality and other recognised charitable organisations

Not for profit organisations whose activities are, in the opinion of Council, in the best interests of the community.

Eligibility

The event must be a local educational, cultural, religious, social or recreational event conducted by a noncommercial group.

- The community group <u>must</u> be located within Banyule's municipality to be eligible
- The event being advertised <u>must</u> be occurring within Banyule's municipality

Unfortunately, Council is unable to accommodate applications outside of the eligibility requirements.

Community and charitable groups are only allowed one permit in any six month period.

Site locations is allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Applications must be received no later than four weeks prior to the date in which the applicant wishes to begin advertising.

Signage must not be offensive, indecent or insulting.

Commercial or private businesses are not eligible to apply for Temporary Advertising.

Council has the right to reject any application if it is deemed not to fit within Council guidelines.

Placement of the sign

Council can issue a maximum of two sites per permit, subject to availability.

The permit duration is for 4 week period only, no additional days will be considered.

Applicants can nominate up to three sites listed on the application form, they must be numbered in preferred order.

Artwork must be supplied at the time of application.

No part of the sign may be higher than 3 metres above ground level. The sign must comply with Council's standard dimensions Maximum 1800mm x 1900mm which includes sponsor acknowledgment no more than 400mm x 1800mm.

Sign/s must be removed on the end date listed on the permit. If sign/s are not removed by end date, Council may impound the sign/s with an impound fee to be payable. Council may also issue an Infringement notice to the applicant and sponsoring agent.

The sign must be of sound construction with no protrusions and must be affixed to the site.

The sign/s must not obstruct or obscure the sight distance of motor vehicle or pedestrians.

Where applicable, the sign must be set back a minimum of three metres from any street.

If your preferred location is not listed on this application form, you may be required to obtain a planning permit. You can contact the Planning Team on 9490 4222.
