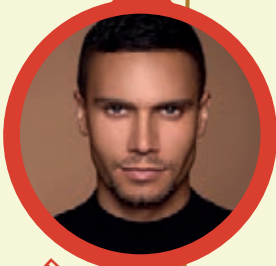
Let's join them in singing and celebrating together, as one.

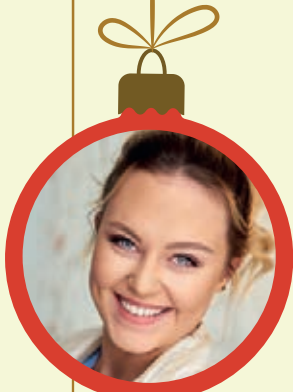

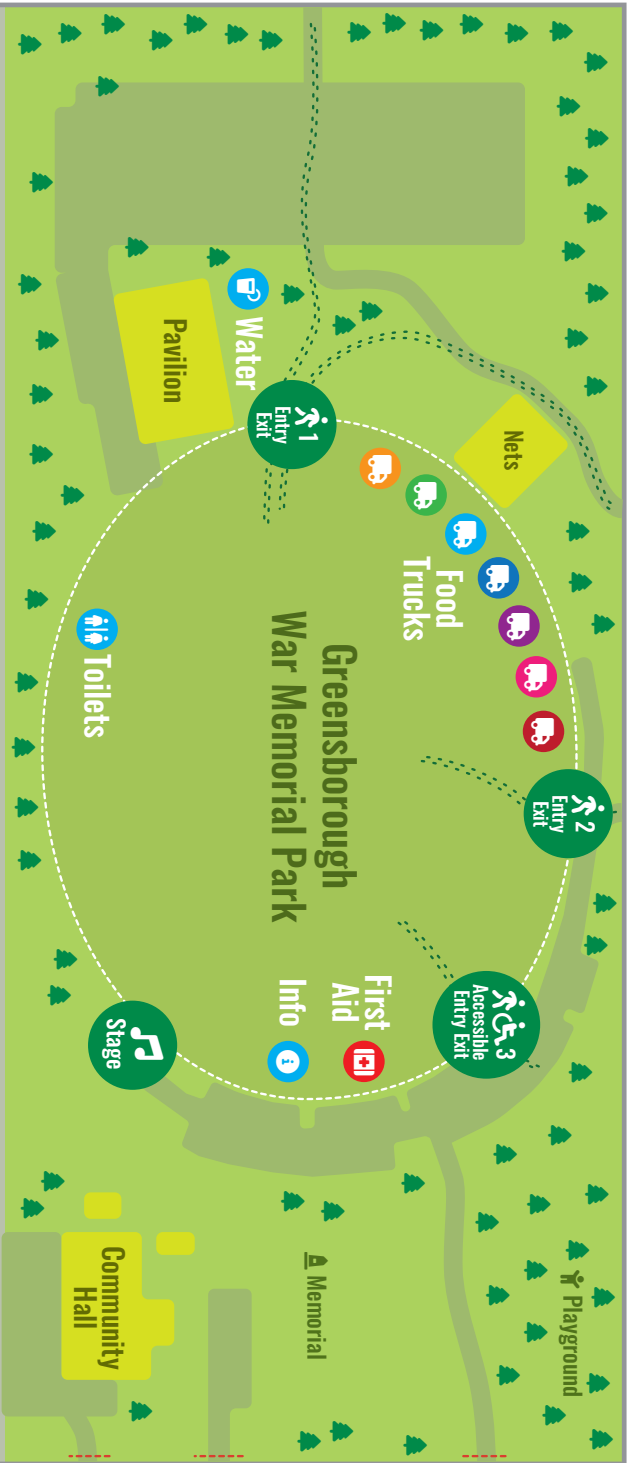
