Community Local Law 2025



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Part 1: Preliminary

1.1 Title

This Local Law is titled the Banyule City Council Community Local Law 2025.

1.2 Objectives

The objectives of this Local Law are to:

- a) provide for the peace, order and good government of the *municipal district*;
- b) preserve and enhance amenity, neighbourhood character, health and public safety by regulating certain activities and the condition of *land*;
- c) protect any assets vested in, controlled or owned by Council;
- d) ensure the safety and amenity of the municipality by controlling activities associated with *building* or construction work;
- e) prohibit persons from causing damage to a *municipal place* or endangering the safety of other persons on *Council Land*;
- f) minimise the adverse impact of animals kept as pets in the community; and
- g) ensure the amenity of *Council's municipal district* is maintained through the safe and efficient collection of domestic *waste* and *hard waste*.

1.3 Authorising Provisions

This Local Law is made under section 71 of the *Local Government Act 2020* and section 42 of the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*.

1.4 Commencement, Revocation and Area of Operation

- 1) This Local Law:
 - I. commences on 16 April 2025;
 - II. ceases to operate on 16 April 2035; and
 - III. applies throughout the *municipal district*.
- 2) On the commencement of this Local Law, Council's General Local Law No.1 (2015) is revoked, save that any notice or consent given, or any business, matter or thing commenced, made or done under that Local Law, is not affected.
- 3) Anything allowed under any Act, Regulation or Planning Scheme, is not affected by any prohibition, requirement or restriction under this Local Law.

1.5 Incorporated Documents

The following documents as made by Council and published from time to time on Council's website, have been incorporated by reference into this Local Law:

- Footpath Trading Policy;
- 2) Parklet Policy; and
- 3) Residential Vehicle Crossing Policy.

1.6 Application

- 1) This Local Law does not apply to any *person* employed or engaged in any authorised activity or duty being undertaken by or on behalf of *Council*.
- 2) The requirement to obtain a *permit* under this Local Law does not apply to a *person* employed or engaged in any authorised activity or duty being undertaken by or on behalf of *Council*.

1.7 Definitions

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Part 2: Administration and Enforcement

2.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to provide for the delegated authority to issue *permits*, impound items or things, set fees and charges, and enforce provisions of this Local Law, including offences, penalties, *Notices to Comply*, appeals and infringement notices.

2.2 Delegations and Authorisations

In accordance with section 78 of the Act, the Council delegates to:

- a) the Chief Executive Officer;
- b) all persons who are members of Council staff appointed as Authorised Officers; and
- c) to any person authorised by Council to act for these persons –

all the powers, discretions, authorities and considerations of *Council* under this Local Law including the powers, discretions and authority to –

- I. issue or refuse *permits*;
- II. amend, revoke, suspend or cancel permits;
- III. fix conditions and durations of time relevant to permits;
- IV. require additional information from *permit* applicants;
- V. apply guidelines or policies of *Council*;
- VI. waive the need for any *permit*;
- VII. waive any fee or charge for any permit;
- VIII. issue, amend, revoke, suspend or cancel a Notice to Comply; or
- IX. do any act, matter or thing necessary or incidental to the exercise of any function or power by the *Council*.

2.3 Permit Applications

- a) An application for a *permit* must be in the form prescribed by *Council* and must be accompanied by the appropriate fee, as determined by *Council*.
- b) Council may require additional information to enable an application for a *permit* to be properly considered and for the purposes of administering and enforcing the provisions of this Local Law.
- c) Council may require a person making an application for a permit to give notice of the application to persons who may be affected by the granting of the permit which will entitle those persons to make a submission which must be considered by Council before a determination is made on the application.

2.4 Consideration of Permit Applications

- 1) In considering an application for a *permit, Council* must consider any:
 - a) policy, code of practice or guideline approved by Council from time to time;
 - b) written objection, submission or comment received by any person, public body or community organisation in respect of the application; and
 - c) other relevant matter.

- 2) A permit may be issued with or without conditions including:
 - a) the payment of a fee or charge;
 - b) a standard to be applied;
 - c) a time limit to be applied either specifying the duration, commencement or completion time or date;
 - d) the issuing of the *permit* subject to the happening of an event;
 - e) the rectification, remedying or restoration of a situation or circumstance;
 - f) the granting of some other *permit* which may be required by *Council* whether under this Local Law or otherwise; and
 - g) any other matters as considered appropriate.
- 3) If the applicant is not the *owner* of the *land* which is the subject of the application, the consent of the *owner* of that *land* must be provided to *Council* with the application.

2.5 Duration

A *permit* operates for one year after the date of issue, except where expressly stated in the *permit*.

2.6 Amendment, Cancellation or Correction

- 1) Council may amend a condition of a permit or cancel a permit at any time if:
 - a) it is requested to do so by the permit holder;
 - b) the Council considers that there has been -
 - I. a material misstatement or concealment of fact in relation to the application for the *permit*;
 - II. any material mistake in relation to the issue of the *permit*;
 - III. any material change of circumstances which has occurred since the grant of the *permit*; or
 - IV. a failure to comply with a *permit* condition or *Notice to Comply* relating to the *permit*.
- 2) *Council* may correct a *permit* issued if that *permit* contains:
 - a) a clerical mistake or an error arising from an accident, slip or omission;
 - b) a material miscalculation of figures; or
 - c) a material mistake in the description of any *person*, thing or property referred to in the *permit*.
- 3) If Council proposes to amend a condition of a permit, cancel a permit or correct a permit, it must:
 - a) give the *permit* holder an opportunity to make submissions on whether the amendment, cancellation or correction should occur; and
 - b) take into account those submissions before making a decision.
- 4) If a *permit* holder is not the *owner* of the *land* and the *owner's* consent was required to be given to the application for the *permit*, the *owner* of the *land* must be notified of any amendment, cancellation or correction to a *permit*.
- 5) Council must note any amendment, cancellation or correction of a *permit* in the register of *permits*.

2.7 Transferability of Permits

Unless otherwise stated in the *permit*, a *permit*:

- a) authorises only the *person* or agent acting on behalf of the *person* named in the *permit* to carry out the activity authorised; and
- b) is not transferable without the written consent of Council.

2.8 Power to Impound

- 1) An *Authorised Officer* may impound any item or thing associated with a contravention of this Local Law, from a *person* owning or who is at the relevant time, responsible for that item or thing.
- 2) As soon as practicable after impounding any item or thing, an *Authorised Officer* must serve a Notice of Impoundment on the *owner* or *person* responsible for the item or thing setting out:
 - a) the fees and charges payable;
 - b) the time within which the impounded item or thing must be claimed; and
 - c) that the item or thing, if not claimed, may be disposed of by Council.
- 3) If an *Authorised Officer* has impounded any item or thing in accordance with this Local Law, the *Council* may *refuse* to release it until the appropriate fee or charge has been paid to the *Council*.
- 4) Any impounded item or thing not claimed within the time specified in the Notice of Impoundment, may be disposed of by *Council*.

2.9 Setting Fees and Charges

- 1) Council may from time to time by resolution, determine the fees, charges, guarantee or bond amounts to apply under this Local Law.
- 2) Council may from time to time by resolution, determine an administrative, inspection or processing fee or charge in addition to a standard fee, charge, guarantee or bond applied under this Local Law.
- 3) Council must give reasonable public notice of its resolution to alter fees and charges.
- 4) In determining any fees and charges *Council* may establish a system or structure of fees and charges, including a minimum or maximum fee or charge, if it considers it is appropriate to do so.
- 5) The *Council*, may waive, reduce, alter or refund in whole or in part, any fee, charge, bond or guarantee with or without conditions.

2.10 Offences

- 1) A person is guilty of an offence under this Local Law if the person fails to:
 - a) comply with any provision of this Local Law;
 - b) comply with a document incorporated by reference;
 - c) obtain a permit under this Local Law;
 - d) comply with a condition of a *permit* issued under this Local Law;
 - e) comply with a Notice to Comply issued under this Local Law;
 - f) comply with any direction of an Authorised Officer;
 - g) comply with a sign erected by Council; or
 - h) comply with a direction contained within a Notice of Impoundment.

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2) Where a corporation commits an offence under this Local law, any directors or officers of that corporation also commit an offence.

2.11 Notices to Comply

- 1) The *Council* may, by serving a *Notice to Comply*, direct any *person* to remedy any thing which constitutes an offence under this Local Law within the time specified in that Notice.
- 2) If a *Notice to Comply* has been issued in relation to a *permit* and the *permit* holder is not the *owner* of the *land* and the *owner's* consent was required to be given for the application of the *permit*, the *permit* holder must notify the *owner* of the *land* of the *Notice to Comply* and the reason why it was served.

2.12 Power to Act in Urgent Circumstances

- 1) An *Authorised Officer* may in urgent circumstances arising from a failure to comply with this Local Law, take action to remedy the situation without the necessity to serve a *Notice to Comply* if the *Authorised Officer* considers the circumstances or situation to be sufficiently urgent and that the time involved or difficulties associated with serving a *Notice to Comply*, may place a *person*, *animal*, property or thing at risk or in danger.
- 2) Details of the circumstances and remedying action taken by *Council* are, as soon as possible, to be forwarded to the *person* on whose behalf the action was taken.
- 3) The action taken by an *Authorised Officer* under this clause, must not extend beyond what is reasonably necessary to remedy the risk or danger involved.

2.13 Appeals

- 1) Any *person* who is aggrieved by any direction given or *Notice to Comply* issued in accordance with this Local Law may, within 28 days after the date of issue of the direction or *Notice to Comply*, make a written submission for consideration by *Council*.
- 2) Where a *person* has made a written submission for consideration by *Council* under this clause that *person* is not relieved of their obligation to comply with the direction or *Notice to Comply*, unless or until a decision on the appeal has been made.

2.14 Infringement Notices

- 1) As an alternative to issuing prosecution proceedings, an *Authorised Officer* may serve an infringement notice on any *person* who has committed an offence under this Local Law.
- 2) The infringement notice penalty in respect of an offence under this Local Law is set out in Schedule 1.

2.15 General Penalty at the Magistrates' Court

Any person who is guilty of an offence against this Local Law is liable to:

- a) a penalty of not more than 20 penalty units; and
- b) for a continuing offence, a penalty not more than 2 *penalty units* for each day after the finding of guilt during which the contravention continues.

Part 3: Asset Protection, Building Sites & Vehicle

Crossings

3.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to protect any asset vested in, controlled or owned by *Council* and to ensure the safety and amenity of the municipality by controlling activities associated with *building* work or construction work.

3.2 Damage and Interference with Council Assets

A *person* must not, without a *permit*, destroy, damage, deface, interfere with, excavate or tap into any Council asset, including any:

- a) fence, grass, plant, tree, tree band/guard, sign, sprinkler, service conduit, hydrant, nature strip or other asset;
- b) drain;
- c) watercourse, ditch, creek, gutter, tunnel, bridge, levee or culvert;
- d) parking sensors;
- e) line marking;
- f) bollards;
- g) street furniture, including shelters;
- h) bike rails;
- i) public bins; or
- j) Council building -

vested in, controlled or owned by Council.

3.3 Asset Protection Permit

- 1) Where *building work* is to be carried out on *land*:
 - a) the owner of the relevant land;
 - b) the builder engaged to carry out building work on the land;
 - c) any appointed agent;
 - d) the developer of that *land; or*
 - e) any demolition contractor engaged to demolish some object on the *land* as part of the *building work* -

must:

- I. not carry out or allow to be carried out *building work* on that *land* unless an *Asset Protection Permit* has been obtained;
- II. not carry out or allow to be carried out *building work* on that *land* in breach of any conditions of an *Asset Protection Permit* that has been obtained; and
- III. pay any Asset Protection Permit Bond determined by the Council.

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2) If a *person* fails to comply with this clause, *Council* may serve a *Notice to Comply* on that *person* requiring the repair, rectification, reinstatement, replacement or any other work to an asset vested in, controlled or owned by *Council*.

Note: Council will inspect a building site and assess the potential for damage to be caused to Council assets as a result of building works. Council may require the payment of an Asset Protection Permit Bond. An Asset Protection Permit is not consent nor does it provide permission to work from or upon Council Land where additional permits may need to be obtained, including -

- Works Within Road Reserve Consent
- Permit to Occupy Space
- Park Access Permit
- Vehicle Crossing Permit
- Tradesperson / Work Zone Permit

3.4 Discharge into Stormwater

A person must not cause or allow the discharge of any substance other than stormwater into the *Council* stormwater drainage network.

3.5 Containment of Building Sites

The *owner*, *occupier* or *builder* of a *building site* must ensure that *building works* are contained entirely within that *building site*.

3.6 Dust Control

A person carrying out building works, landscaping or gardening works on land must ensure that:

- a) dust, spoil or other material does not escape to adjoining *land* or a *road*, including the depositing of dust or spoil on a *road*; and
- b) adequate dust prevention measures are in place on the *land* to minimise the risk of dust escaping from the *land*.

3.7 Building Site Refuse

The *owner, occupier* or *builder* of a *building site* must ensure that builder's refuse produced as a result of *building works* is:

- a) contained entirely within the building site;
- b) stored within the *building site* in an appropriate receptacle designed for the collection of such materials;
- c) stored in a manner that does not attract the depositing of builder's refuse from sources other than the *building site*;
- d) stored in a manner that does not cause detriment to the visual amenity of the area in which the building site is located; and
- e) disposed of regularly to a facility lawfully established for collection purposes.

3.8 Building Hours

An *owner*, *occupier* or *builder* must not, without a *permit*, cause or allow *building works* or other activities to be carried out on *land*:

- a) before 7 am or after 6 pm Monday to Friday;
- b) before 9 am or after 3 pm on a Saturday;
- c) on a Sunday; or
- d) on a gazetted public holiday.

3.9 Direction to Cease Building Works

An *owner*, *occupier* or *builder* must cease *building works* immediately, when directed either orally or in writing to do so by an *Authorised Officer*.

3.10 Building Site Fencing

The *owner*, *occupier* or *builder* of a *building site* must ensure that, prior to the commencement of any *building works* and for the duration of the *building works*, the site is provided with adequate temporary site fencing.

3.11 Sanitary Facilities at Building Sites

The owner, occupier or builder of a building site must ensure that sanitary facilities are provided on the building site at the commencement of and for the duration of building works, which:

- a) do not cause odours or detriment to the amenity of the area in which *the building site* is located; and
- b) are maintained in a clean and sanitary condition at all times.

3.12 Construction Management Plan

- 1) Council may require an *owner*, *occupier* or *builder* of a *building site* where *building work* is being undertaken, including demolition work, to prepare a Construction Management Plan if an *Authorised Officer* reasonably considers that the safety of the public, damage to Council assets or the amenity of the area would be assisted by having such a Plan in place.
- 2) A person must comply with the requirements of a Construction Management Plan issued under this clause.

3.13 Tree Protection on Private Land during Building Works

- 1) Where any building work is or is to be carried out on land:
 - a) the owner of the land; or
 - b) the builder engaged to carry out building work on the land -

may, (whether those *building works* are proposed to be undertaken pursuant to a planning *permit* or otherwise) be directed by an *Authorised Officer* to pay a security bond to *Council* in order to safeguard against the damage or destruction of vegetation, including any *significant trees*, on that *land* or any adjoining *land*.

- 2) The security bond shall be for an amount and in a form determined by the Council.
- 3) Within 12 months after the completion of the *building works Council* may:
 - retain all or any part of the security bond to cover costs of replacement of any vegetation damaged or destroyed as a result of the building works; or
 - b) refund the security bond.

3.14 Tree Protection of Council Trees during Building Work

Where any building work is or is to be carried out on land:

- a) the owner of the land;
- b) the builder engaged to carry out building work on the land;
- c) any appointed agent or contractor carrying out building work on the land; or
- d) any demolition contractor engaged to demolish some object on the *land* as part of the *building work* -

must establish and maintain a *Tree Protection Zone* around *Council* trees within the nature strip adjacent to the *land* where the works are occurring.

3.15 Vehicle Crossings

A person must not, without a permit:

- a) construct, install, remove or alter a vehicle crossing; or
- b) construct a temporary vehicle crossing, if it is likely that a *motor vehicle* is accessing *land*.

3.16 Use of Vehicle Crossings

- 1) A *person* must not cause, allow, or drive a *motor vehicle* from or onto *land* other than by an appropriately constructed vehicle crossing.
- 2) An *owner* of *land* must ensure that each point of vehicular access from a *road* to the *land* has an appropriately constructed vehicle crossing.
- 3) An *owner* of *land* must remove a redundant vehicle crossing and reinstate that *land* to Council's satisfaction.

3.17 Maintenance of Vehicle Crossings

The *owner*, *occupier* or *builder* must ensure that each vehicle crossing is maintained to that *land* from an adjacent *road*, including any:

- a) channel or pipe under or forming part of that crossing;
- b) infill from the property boundary to a constructed footpath;
- c) infill from a constructed footpath to the line of the invert of the kerb; and
- d) infill from the property boundary to the line of the invert of the *kerb* if there is no constructed footpath.

3.18 Management of Easements

Where *land* is encumbered by a drainage easement, a *person* must not, without the prior written consent of *Council*:

- a) place any fill within an easement;
- b) excavate any soil or dirt from within the easement;
- c) excavate any soil or dirt from the *land* comprising the easement, in a manner which, in the opinion of an *Authorised Officer*, is likely to affect the flow of water over the easement or on or from *land* adjacent to the easement;
- d) cover any drainage inspection pit or pit lid in a manner which, in the opinion of an *Authorised Officer*, makes it impracticable to conveniently use or access the drainage inspection point or the pit lid for its intended purpose; or
- e) undertake *building work* on, over or within an easement, that in the opinion of an *Authorised Officer* may damage a *Council* drainage system, or limit Council's ability to access, maintain or renew a drainage system.

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Part 4: Roads and Council Land

4.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to protect the safety of road users, the amenity of the municipality and to provide for the fair and equitable use of *Council Land*, including the issuing of resident parking *permits*.

4.2 Street Stalls

A person must not, without a permit, conduct a street stall on a road or on Council Land.

4.3 Busking

A person must not, without a permit, busk on a road or on Council Land.

4.4 Itinerant Trading

A person must not, without a permit, conduct itinerant trading on a road or on Council Land.

4.5 Donation Bins

A person must not, without a permit, place a donation bin on a road or on Council Land.

4.6 Footpath and Parklet Trading

A person must not, without a permit:

- a) display any goods;
- b) place a moveable sign; or
- c) place tables, chairs, outdoor umbrellas, planter boxes, barriers, outdoor heaters or any other item -

on a road or on Council Land.

4.7 Obstructions on Roads and Council Land

A person must not, without a permit, leave, store or allow to be left any:

- a) bulk rubbish container, storage or shipping container, skip bin or trailer skip;
- b) trade waste hopper or bin; or
- c) other thing that encroaches on, or obstructs the free use of -

on a road or on Council Land.

4.8 Camping on Roads or Council Land

A *person* must not, without a *permit*, *camp*, pitch or erect a tent, caravan, campervan, mobile home, other temporary or makeshift structure or provisional form of accommodation or occupy any *motor vehicle* for the purpose of accommodation, on a *road* or on *Council Land*.

4.9 Obstruction of Roads

An owner or occupier of land must not:

- a) allow any tree, hedge, plant or vegetation of any kind to grow; or
- b) construct or place any structure of any kind -

so that it obstructs the view of a *motor vehicle*, sign, lighting, essential services or signal on a *road* by any *person* using that *road*.

4.10 Spoil on Roads

A *person* must not, in the course of any trade, industry or commercial activity:

- a) drive, allow or cause to be driven a *motor vehicle* on a *road* unless the wheels and tyres of the *motor vehicle* are free from soil, earth, clay, mud, liquid *waste* or like substances;
- b) allow any material, produce or substance to fall or escape onto a *road* from any *motor vehicle* which the *person* is driving or any equipment which the *person* is operating; or
- c) allow any grease, oil, mud, clay or like substance to run off a *motor vehicle* the *person* is cleaning onto a *road* or into a drain.

4.11 Unregistered or Abandoned Vehicles

A person must not:

- a) leave any unregistered, derelict or unroadworthy *motor vehicle*, caravan or *trailer*; or
- b) abandon or cause to be abandoned any motor vehicle, caravan or trailer -

on a road or on Council Land.

4.12 Repair of Vehicles

A person must not:

- a) service, paint or dismantle any motor vehicle; or
- b) repair any *motor vehicle*, except where necessary to enable that *motor vehicle* to be removed from being –

on a road or on Council Land.

4.13 Storage of Vehicles

A *person* must not store any caravan, *trailer*, boat or disabled *motor vehicle* on any *road* or on *Council Land*.

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4.14 Sale of Vehicles

The *owner* of a *motor vehicle* must not park or cause the *motor vehicle* to be parked or left, for the purpose of displaying that vehicle for sale, on any *road* or on *Council Land*.

4.15 Shopping Trolleys

- 1) A *person* must not leave a shopping trolley, other than in an area designated for shopping trolley collection.
- 2) Any shopping trolley left in an area not set aside for the purpose of storage of shopping trolleys, may be impounded by an *Authorised Officer*.
- 3) Where a retailer provides shopping trolleys, the retailer must:
 - a) ensure that the shopping trolleys are fitted with either a functioning coin deposit and release mechanism or an alternate, locking mechanism approved by *Council*;
 - b) ensure that no shopping trolley of the business is left on any *road* or *Council Land* unless it is left in an area set aside for shopping trolley collection; and
 - c) demonstrate to Council's satisfaction that they have a regular collection system in place to collect shopping trolleys and implement that system.
- 4) A retailer served with a Notice of Impoundment must collect any impounded shopping trolley within the time specified in that Notice.

NOTE: This provision does not apply to a retailer who provides less than 20 shopping trolleys.

4.16 Parking Permits

- 1) Any *person* who has been allocated a vehicle parking *permit* by *Council* must not:
 - a) sell or offer to sell a vehicle parking permit;
 - b) give away for no charge, or offer to give away for no charge, a vehicle parking *permit* (other than a temporary visitor *permit* to be used by a legitimate visitor);
 - c) lend, license, or offer to lend or license a vehicle parking *permit* (other than a temporary visitor *permit* to be used by a legitimate visitor); or
 - d) otherwise allow a vehicle parking *permit* (other than a temporary visitor *permit* being used by a legitimate visitor) to be used by any *person* other than a vehicle parking *permit* holder.
- 2) A *person* (other than a visitor using a temporary visitor *permit* in accordance with any applicable policies or conditions) must not:
 - a) purchase or induce to purchase;
 - b) receive or induce to receive (whether for a charge or not); or
 - c) accept or induce to receive -
 - a vehicle parking *permit* from any vehicle parking *permit* holder or other *person* not authorised to issue a vehicle parking *permit*.
- 3) A *person* must not use or attempt to use a vehicle parking *permit* who is not the relevant vehicle parking *permit* holder.

NOTE: In this clause, a vehicle parking permit, a temporary visitor permit and accessible parking permits are all deemed to be permits issued under this Local Law.

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Part 5: Consumption of Alcohol and Smoking in Public Places

5.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to control the consumption and possession of alcohol in *public places*, where such consumption or possession may interfere with the amenity and enjoyment of the *public place* and to create designated *Smoke-Free Areas*.

5.2 Declaration of Alcohol restriction areas

- 1) The *Council* may declare an area of the *municipal district* to be an *alcohol restriction area* as shown in the maps contained in Schedule 2.
- 2) Before a declaration is made, the *Council* must give public notice of the proposed declaration.
- 3) After the declaration is made, signage must be erected which designates an area as an *alcohol restriction area*.

5.3 Consumption and Possession of Alcohol

- (1) A person must not, without a permit, in an alcohol restriction area:
 - a) consume alcohol; or
 - b) be in possession of alcohol, other than in a sealed container.
- (2) The requirements of this clause do not apply to a *person*:
 - a) taking part in a festival, procession, street party or other activity in respect of which Council has granted a *permit* for persons to consume alcohol;
 - b) consuming alcohol within premises licensed under the Liquor Control Reform Act 1998; or
 - c) who has been granted a *permit* to take alcohol into an area declared by *Council* to be an *alcohol restriction area*.

5.4 Declaration of Smoke-Free Areas

- 1) The Council may declare an area of the municipal district to be a Smoke-Free Area.
- 2) Before a declaration is made, the *Council* must give public notice of the proposed declaration.
- 3) After the declaration is made, signage must be erected which designates an area as a *Smoke-Free Area*.

5.5 Smoking in Smoke-Free Areas

A person must not smoke in an area declared by Council to be a Smoke-Free Area.

Part 6: Activities on Council Land

6.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to control behaviour and activities to ensure the fair and equitable use of *Council Land* and prohibit persons from causing damage to a *municipal place* or endangering the safety of other persons on *Council Land*.

6.2 Carnivals, Festivals, Processions and Street Parties

A person must not, without a permit, on any Council Land, hold or allow to be held a:

- a) carnival;
- b) festival;
- c) procession; or
- d) street party.

6.3 Activities on Council Land

A person must not, without a permit on Council Land:

- a) light a fire or allow any fire to remain alight except in:
 - I. a barbeque provided by *Council*; or
 - II. a portable liquid petroleum gas barbecue;
- b) ride or drive a vehicle or *animal* in a manner or in a place which is likely to damage or ruin any grassed area or turf surface or otherwise interfere with the use of *Council Land* by another *person*;
- c) hang, place, affix or erect any advertising sign or advertisement;
- d) play, organise, practise or engage in any organised competitive sport or game;
- e) engage in, play or practice any game or sport in such a manner as to be a danger to the safety of any *person*;
- f) operate or allow to be operated, any amusement for which a charge is paid;
- g) make a collection for money;
- h) use any sound amplification device;
- i) hold any event, commercial or promotional activity; or
- j) conduct personal training services for individuals or groups for which a fee is charged.

6.4 Behaviour in a Municipal Place or on Council Land

A person must not, in a municipal place or on Council Land:

- a) interfere with the guiet enjoyment of the *land* by any other person;
- b) do anything which may endanger a person;
- c) behave in a manner which is offensive, indecent, insulting, riotous or disorderly or engage in any conduct which is dangerous;
- d) destroy, damage, write upon or interfere with any thing;

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- e) unless the person is a player, official or competitor at any sports match or sports gathering authorised under this Part, enter or remain within or upon the playing arena during the progress of such sports match or sports gathering; or
- f) park a vehicle in an area which is not designated for parking.

6.5 Access to Council Land

A *person* must not, without a *permit*, install or maintain a pedestrian gate, vehicle gate or similar structure to facilitate entry into *Council Land* from privately owned *land*.

6.6 Planting on Nature Strips

A *person* must not, unless in accordance with the Council's Nature Strip Planting Guidelines displayed on Council's website;

- a) plant any tree or vegetation on; or
- b) carry out works which alters the appearance of -

a nature strip being Council Land.

6.7 Feeding of Birds

A person must not feed birds on Council Land or in a public place.

Part 7: Resident Responsibilities

7.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Part is to preserve and enhance amenity, neighbourhood character, accessibility, health and public safety by regulating certain activities on *land*.

7.2 Condition of Land

- 1) An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must not cause or allow that *land*, including any *buildings* on that *land*, to be kept in a manner which is:
 - a) unsightly; or
 - b) dangerous or likely to cause danger to life or property.
- 2) For the purposes of this clause, unsightly *land* includes *land* which:
 - a) contains unconstrained rubbish;
 - b) contains disused excavation or waste material;
 - c) contains graffiti on any building, structure or boundary fence;
 - d) contains deteriorated, disassembled or incomplete vehicles visible from the *road* adjacent to the *land*;
 - e) is detrimental to the general amenity of the neighbourhood in which it is located;
 - f) contains noxious weeds;
 - g) contains unkempt grass or vegetation;
 - h) contains machinery or machinery parts visibly stored on the *land* for more than 2 months; or
 - i) contains disassembled, incomplete or deteriorated *motor vehicles*, caravans, *trailers* or similar items, visibly stored on the *land* for more than 2 months.
- 3) For the purposes of this clause, dangerous *land* includes *land* which contains the presence or storage of any item, matter, thing or condition likely to cause a risk to health or safety, excluding trees on privately owned *land*, unless such trees pose a safety risk to a *public place*.

7.3 Vacant Land and Abandoned Buildings

- 1) An *owner* of any vacant *land* must not allow that *land* to become unsafe.
- 2) An *owner* of *land* occupied by any abandoned *building* must not allow the abandoned *building* to become *dilapidated* or fall into disrepair.

7.4 Maintenance of Private Drains and Stormwater Retention Systems

An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must ensure that any drain or stormwater retention system on the *land*, that is not vested in *Council* or another public authority, is operated and maintained for the purpose for which it is designed.

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7.5 Overhanging or Encroaching

An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must not cause or allow any tree, hedge, plant or vegetation of any kind to:

- a) overhang or encroach any footway at a height less than 2.5m;
- b) overhang or encroach any road at a height less than 4.5m; or
- c) obstruct a footpath.

7.6 Property Numbers

- 1) An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must, if *Council* has allocated a number to that *land*, ensure that the allocated number is appropriately positioned so that it is clearly visible from the adjoining *road*.
- 2) An *owner* of *occupier* of *land* must not assign a property number other than the number allocated by Council to that *land*.

7.7 Refrigerators and Ice Chests

A *person* must not allow the placement of any disused refrigerator, ice chest, ice box, trunk, chest or other similar article, on a *road*, *public place* or *Council Land*, without first removing every door, lid, lock and/or hinge rendering the item incapable of being fastened.

7.8 Fires and Fire Pits

- 1) A *person* must not, without a *permit*, allow to be lit or remain alight any fire or fire in a *fire pit* in the open air on any *land*.
- 2) The requirements of this clause do not apply if the fire is lit:
 - a) by a public body engaged in fire protection measures;
 - b) in a purpose built outdoor cooking and/or heating device; or
 - c) for ceremonial purposes.

7.9 Extinguishing Fires

A *person* who has lit or allowed a fire to remain alight contrary to clause 7.8, or any condition contained in a *permit*, must extinguish the fire immediately on being directed to do so by:

- a) an Authorised Officer;
- b) a member of the Victoria Police acting in the course of their duties; or
- c) an officer of a recognised fire service.

7.10 Environmental Weeds

An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* affected by an Environmental Significance, Significant *Land* scape or Vegetation Protection Overlay under the Banyule Planning Scheme, must remove environmental weeds as identified within the Banyule Weed Management Strategy displayed on Council's website from that *land* when directed to do so by an *Authorised Officer*, after having obtained necessary planning approvals.

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7.11 Maintenance of Nature Strips

An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must ensure that the nature strip located adjacent to that *land* does not contain lawn or weeds exceeding 30cm in height.

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Part 8: Animals

8.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to minimise the adverse impact of *animals* kept as pets in the *municipal district*.

8.2 Application of Part

This Part does not apply to *land* used for the purposes of conducting a pet shop, animal hospital, animal breeding facility, veterinary practice or domestic animal business where such a use is *permit*ted under the Banyule Planning Scheme or the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*.

8.3 Permitted Number of Animals Kept on Private Land

An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must not, without a *permit*, keep or allow to be kept, on any one parcel of *land* which is less than 4000 square meters:

- a) an emu, ostrich, alpaca, cow, pig, camel, donkey, goat, sheep, bull, horse or any other agricultural *animal*; or
- b) any more in number of each type of *animal* than is listed in the table below:

Type of Animal Max. Allo	Max. Allowed	
Dogs 2		
Cats 2		
Poultry 10		
Pigeons & Domestic Birds 20		
Guinea Pigs 4		
Domestic Rabbits 4		
Rooster 0		

NOTE: The maximum number of permitted animals does not apply to animals under the age of 12 weeks, except for roosters which are prohibited.

8.4 Housing of Animals

The owner or occupier of any land on which any animal is kept must ensure that:

- a) the ground surrounding the place where the *animal* is kept is free from dry grass, weeds, *refuse*, rubbish or other material capable of harbouring rodents or *vermin*;
- b) the place where the animal is kept and the surrounding area is well drained;

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- c) all food for consumption by the *animal* is kept or stored in a *vermin* proof receptacle;
- d) any area where the *animal* is kept is thoroughly cleaned as often as necessary to keep the area clean and sanitary at all times;
- e) all manure, excrement, *refuse* or rubbish produced or accumulated by the *animal* is disposed of, so that it does not cause a nuisance or create a condition which is offensive or dangerous to health; and
- f) the *land* is adequately fenced so as to prevent any *animal* kept on that *land* from escaping.

8.5 Noise of Animals

An *owner* or *occupier* of any *land* where an *animal* is kept must not allow any noise or smell to emanate from the *animal* which interferes with the reasonable comfort or convenience of another *person*.

NOTE: Dogs and cats creating a nuisance are covered by the Domestic Animals Act 1994.

8.6 Dog Excrement

Where a dog enters a *public place*, the *owner* or person in control of that dog must:

- a) remove and dispose of faeces deposited by the dog;
- b) carry a litter device; and
- c) produce the *litter device* when requested to do so by an *Authorised Officer*.

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Part 9: Public Health

9.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is protect the health and wellbeing of the community by regulating certain activities affecting public health.

9.2 Chimneys, Purpose Built Outdoor Cooking and Heating Devices

An owner or occupier of any land must not cause or allow any chimney or purpose built outdoor cooking and / or heating device to discharge any by-products of combustion to such an extent that, in the opinion of an Authorised Officer, it is considered unreasonable or is dangerous to the health or safety of any person or animal.

9.3 Audible Alarms

The *owner* or *occupier* of any *land* must not install, cause or allow any audible alarm to be heard continuously beyond the boundary of such *land* within any residential or commercial *building* for more than 10 minutes, or intermittently for more than 10 minutes in total within a one hour period.

9.4 Vermin and Hazardous Pests

- 1) The *owner* or *occupier* of the *land* must not allow the *land* to be kept in a manner, condition or state where, in the opinion of an *Authorised Officer*:
 - a) vermin or hazardous pests are being attracted or likely to be attracted onto that land;
 - b) vermin or hazardous pests are harbouring on that land; or
 - *c)* the condition of the *land* is likely to provide harbourage for *vermin or hazardous pests*.
- 2) Upon being made aware by an *Authorised Officer* of the presence of *vermin* and/or *hazardous pests* on the *land*, the *owner* or *occupier* of the *land* must remove or eradicate, to the satisfaction of the *Authorised Officer*, such *vermin* and/or *hazardous pests*.

9.5 Camping on Private Land

A person must not camp, cause or allow another person to camp on any privately owned land:

- a) unless such camping takes place within a registered caravan park or camping area, or
- b) unless, in the opinion of an Authorised Officer, adequate sanitary facilities are in place.

9.6 Hygiene Requirements for Personal Care and Body Art Businesses

The proprietor of a premises registered under section 69 of the *Public Health and Wellbeing Act 2008* to conduct the business of hairdressing, colonic irrigation, beauty therapy, tattooing, ear piercing or any other process involving the penetration of a person's skin, must ensure that the premises contains accessible hand washing facilities with:

a) a continuous supply of both hot and cold water;

- b) soap; and
- c) paper towel.

9.7 Reuse of Domestic Greywater

A *person* must not use untreated *greywater* to irrigate any residential *land* if, in the opinion of an *Environmental Health Officer*, its reuse is considered inappropriate or poses or is likely to pose a risk to the health of any *person* or *animal*.

9.8 Asbestos Management from Domestic Sources

A *person*, other than a *person* licenced or otherwise allowed under the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2017*, must not *handle* or *store* any item or thing containing or potentially containing asbestos, if in the opinion of an *Authorised Officer*, a risk of asbestos fibres becoming or likely of becoming airborne exists.

Part 10: Business Activities

10.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to regulate the impact of business activities on the environment, public health and amenity.

10.2 Storage of Trade Waste

The *owner* or *occupier* of a commercial or industrial premises must provide *trade waste* hoppers, bins or storage containers for the storage of *trade waste* at that premises which are:

- a) constructed of impervious materials, water tight and pest proof;
- b) emptied before it overflows;
- c) maintained in a clean, inoffensive and sanitary condition;
- d) in sufficient numbers to contain all the waste produced;
- e) stored in an area and in a manner to the satisfaction of an Authorised Officer;
- f) stored in such a manner that it cannot contaminate or enter the stormwater system; and
- g) supplied with such equipment as will enable the clean-up of any spilt material.

10.3 Pick Up and Delivery to Commercial Premises

A *person* may pick up or deliver or cause to be picked up or delivered any goods, including *trade waste* hoppers, bins or containers for the storage of *trade waste* to commercial premises, between the hours of:

- a) 6.30am and 10pm Monday to Saturday; or
- b) 9am and 10pm on a Sunday or on a gazetted Public Holiday –

provided that the collection or delivery does not create an unreasonable noise or affects the amenity of the area.

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Part 11: Waste Collection and Disposal

11.1 Purpose

The purpose of this part is to ensure the amenity of *Council's municipal district* is maintained through the safe and efficient collection of domestic *waste* and *hard waste* placed on a *road* for collection, and the depositing of *waste* in street bins and park bins.

11.2 Placement of Waste for Collection

- 1) A person not:
 - a) place out for collection more than 1 *waste* bin, 1 organic bin and 1 recycling bin, unless authorised by *Council*;
 - b) place out for collection any mobile *waste*, organic or recycling bin so as to cause a hazard to a pedestrian, vehicle or *person* undertaking the collection and processing, for or on behalf of the *Council*; and
 - c) remove, damage or interfere with:
 - I. another property's bin or hard waste;
 - II. the contents of another property's bin or hard waste placed out for collection; or
 - III. place additional material into another property's bin or hard waste.
- 2) Any mobile *waste*, organic or recycling bin placed out for collection by an *owner* or *occupier* of *land* must:
 - a) be positioned on the nature strip adjacent to the kerb or at such other place as may from time to time be approved by the Council, and in excess of 1 metre from any obstacle; and
 - b) be placed no earlier than 3.00pm on the day prior to the day of collection.
- 3) An *owner* or *occupier* of *land* is responsible for removing any *waste* or material which has escaped or spilled onto any *road*, nature strip or surrounding area from a mobile *waste*, organic or recycling bin or *hard waste* left out by the *owner* or *occupier* for collection.

11.3 Maintenance of Waste, Organic and Recycling Bins

- 1) An owner or occupier of land must:
 - a) keep their mobile *waste*, organic or recycling bin in a clean, inoffensive and sanitary condition; and
 - b) ensure that any area where a bin is placed between collections is kept in a clean, inoffensive and sanitary condition.
- 2) A mobile waste, organic and recycling bin, when placed for collection and containing waste, must be covered by its lid at all times, except when items are being deposited in or removed from the bin.

11.4 Removal of Waste, Organic and Recycling Bins

An *owner* or *occupier* must return any empty mobile *waste*, organic or recycling bin within the allocated property within 24 hours of having been emptied by any *waste* collector.

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11.5 Hard Waste Collection

If Council has accepted a household *hard waste* collection booking, the materials to be collected must be placed:

- a) on the nature strip or other agreed location not earlier than 5 days prior to the booking collection date; and
- b) in a neat, tidy, safe and orderly manner.

11.6 Street Bins and Park Bins

A *person* must not deposit any residential *waste*, green *waste*, *trade waste* or commercial *waste* into any street bin or park bin.
