Budget 2025/26: Delivering for our community

Banyule remains in a sustainable financial position with our Budget for 2025/26.

Council's focus is on providing quality services and facilities to meet the needs of our growing community while managing debt.

We're maintaining our core service delivery such collecting rubbish, looking after roads, parks and sports grounds, and providing maternal and child health services and libraries.

More than 80% of the \$73.1 million capital works budget is to renew and upgrade existing assets.

I recently met with the Federal Minister for Local Government Kristy McBain, about funding needed in Banyule. It's vital that we advocate for support from other levels of government to help provide the infrastructure and services our community needs.

Initiatives in our neighbourhood:

- Improving the Waterdale Rd shopping centre streetscape: \$60,000
- Upgrading outdoor dining parklets across Banyule with new paving and street furniture (including in Upper Heidelberg Road): \$380,000
- Upgrading the school change facilities at Ivanhoe Aquatic: \$75,000
- Ivanhoe Aquatic pool plant replacement program: \$61,000
- Traffic calming measures in Upper Heidelberg Road: \$107,000
- Building female-friendly change rooms at Seddon Reserve Pavilion: \$375,000.
