Olympic Park transformation enters final lap

We appreciate your patience while we build the new community sports pavilion and public toilets between the north and south ovals at Olympic Park. Some of you have had to adjust your walking and cycling routes to bypass the building site. Signs in the area show the detours.

We're also working on landscaping, trees and paths around the grounds as well as renovations and gardens at Barrbunin Beek Aboriginal Gathering Place. Work should be finished by the end of this year, completing the transformation of Olympic Park into a premier league regional sports facility, recreation park and community sports and leisure hub.

Originally due to finish in 2030, the project will be completed much sooner thanks to the Victorian Government adding \$8 million to Council's \$10 million commitment.
